<p>In addition to any other qualifications prescribed by law, the mayor and each councilmember shall meet the following conditions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • BE A UNITED STATES CITIZEN • HAVE BEEN A RESIDENT OF TEXAS AND THE CITY OF NASSAU BAY FOR AT LEAST TWELVE (12) MONTHS IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING ELECTION DAY PER THE STATE OF TEXAS ELECTION CODE • HAVE BEEN REGISTERED TO VOTE FOR AT LEAST ONE (1) YEAR • BE TWENTY-ONE (21) YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER UPON THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE TERM TO BE FILLED AT THE ELECTION • HAVE NOT BEEN CONVICTED OF A FELONY OR AN OFFENSE INVOLVING MORAL TURPITUDE FOR WHICH THE PERSON HAS NOT BEEN PARDONED OR OTHERWISE RELEASED FROM THE RESULTING DISABILITIES • NOT HAVE BEEN FOUND MENTALLY INCOMPETENT BY A FINAL JUDGMENT OF A COURT 	<p>The filing period begins on the 78th day prior to the election date and ends on the 78th day at 5:00pm prior to the election date.</p> <p>Pursuant to Home Rule Charter ARTICLE III. THE CITY COUNCIL Sec. 3.01 Number, Selection and Term of Office.</p> <p>The legislative and governing body of the City shall consist of a mayor and six (6) councilmembers and shall be known as the "City Council of the City of Nassau Bay, Harris County, Texas."</p> <p>(A) The mayor and councilmembers shall be elected by the qualified voters of the city at large for a two (2) year term. Each councilmember shall occupy a position on the council, such positions being numbered 1 through 6.</p> <p>(B) Each odd numbered year, three (3) councilmembers shall be elected to fill positions 1, 3 and 5. Each even numbered year, the mayor and three (3) councilmembers shall be elected with the councilmembers filling positions 2, 4, and 6.</p> <p>(C) No person shall be elected to council more than four (4) consecutive times.</p> <p>All elections shall be held in the manner provided for by this charter, and the election laws of the State of Texas.</p>
