Re: Flood Protection Assistance

Residents can obtain information of flood protection assistance from the City of Nassau Bay Building Department. Flood protection assistance may include site-specific flood and flood related data, data on historical flooding in the neighborhood, and sources for financial assistance.

The Building office offers property protection 1-on-1 advice, such as retrofitting techniques and drainage improvements. A site visit may be required in order to properly evaluate the property before providing advice. The City will provide financial assistance advice (FAA) on certain financial assistance programs that may be available through Federal, State and County governmental entities. This advisory service is part of the City's Program for Public Information (PPI).

The Building Department Personnel are qualified to provide all aspects of Flood Protection Assistance available. The City also has staff through our contract Engineering Office that are available to answer questions as well.

Flood Protection Assistance Notification is publicized on our website and posted in our City newsletters and included in a mailing to all homeowners twice a year.
