



Attention, local restaurants!

Are you interested in participating in the City's upcoming STREET EATZ event? For the first time ever, the City is giving local restaurants the opportunity to set up food and non-alcoholic beverage samples for distribution during the event.

Here's what you need to know:

STREET EATZ is just around the corner – the fun will take place on Saturday, October 15 from 6PM to 10PM in the Town Square!

This year, Nassau Bay restaurants will be allowed to set up tables (tents MUST be limited to 10x10 and furnished by the restaurant) with food and non-alcoholic beverage samples. We recommend preparing or bringing supplies for approximately 250-300 samples.

Restaurants are strongly encouraged to bring flyers and coupons for distribution to attendees.

Set-up:

Participating restaurants will set up tables along the Saturn Lane esplanade. Electricity will be available in a limited amount, based on participation. Participating restaurants will be responsible for securing any power cords or other trip hazards prior to the event.

Required Documentation:

By law, a food establishment must have a permit from Harris County Public Health to operate. As well, participating restaurants will need to complete a Temporary Event Operator Application through Harris County Public Health. Additional information is available at hcphth.org.

Deadline for participation:

Those businesses who wish to participate MUST complete their Temporary Event Operator Applications AND notify the City no later than MONDAY, OCTOBER 3. This will allow the City time to verify application approval through Harris County Public Health and plan placement of each participating restaurant along the Saturn Lane esplanade.
